



City of Huntington Beach Film, Video and Still Photography Permit Fees

APPLICATION SUBMITTAL FEE:

\$300.00	General – (Government projects and same-day breaking news are exempt)
\$150.00	Still Photography
\$50.00	Student Project (with verification)

BUSINESS LICENSE FEE:

\$137.30	Required for all commercial agencies filming on public or private property.

PERMIT ISSUANCE FEE:

Exemptions from daily fees include, student course work with instructor verification, government agencies, and same day "breaking" news.

Commercial Filming Permit Fee:	
\$500.00	Peak (April-October) – Per Day
\$300.00	Off-Peak (November-March – Per Day
Still Photography Permit Fee:	
\$150.00	Per Day
City Coordination Fee:	
15%	Added to Total Billable Fees
Site Visit:	
No Charge	First Visit
\$150	Each Additional Visit

Production on private property impacting city owned streets, neighborhoods and right-of-way requires coordinator, permit and applicable fees.

ADDITIONAL FEES:

50% of regular daily charges apply for 4 hours or less on application

ADDITIONAL PERMITTING FEES:

Fee	Details/When Required	Amount
Marine Safety Officer	Filming in water Driving on sand or beach path Obstructing public access to beach space Filming on the Pier	\$90/hour per officer +1 hour (i.e. 2 hour reservation is charged for 3 hours)
Police Officer	Driving shots (as needed) Fight scenes Road closures (as needed) Large, attract set pieces, pyrotechnics, etc.	\$120/hour per officer (will be adjusted for actual costs)
Beach Parking Spaces	Reserving or using parking space at the beach/downtown	\$15/day per space
Application of Parking Restrictions	Applied when temporary parking restrictions are required i.e. "No Parking" areas on street	\$140
Location Use Fee	When filming on public points of interest: beach space, Central Park, Pier, Library, etc.	Determined on case-by-case basis by scope of permit
