DeKalb Peachtree Airport (PDK) is the second busiest airport in Georgia behind Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta International Airport. Due to the unique nature of the Airport environment, PDK has established mandatory policies and procedures to accommodate film, photography, video, production and pre-production activities while avoiding negatively impacting the safety and efficiency of Airport operations.

DeKalb-Peachtree Airport (PDK) is a county-owned, public-use airport located in the City of Chamblee in DeKalb County, Georgia. All film permits for a county owned facility must go through the DeKalb Entertainment Commission (DEC) film permit office and the City of Chamblee thus two permits are required for filming.

Permits are required if a production includes any of the following:

- Filming on PDK property or any parts thereof (i.e. privately owned hangers)
- Drone use in DeKalb County*
- Helicopter use in DeKalb County*

*Please note that DeKalb County Police Department (DKPD) is notified via the DEC to alert DKPD Aerial support for drones and helicopters used in production shoots.

Below are instructions for filming at PDK:

1. Contact DEC and Chamblee Film Offices – Please send an email to DEC’s production manager and the City of Chamblee with the following information:
 - a. Date(s) and times for filming, including prep and strike
 - b. Brief description of shoot
 - c. Size of crew and number of vehicles on property
2. Schedule a Tech Scout - Prior to completing a film permit application, a **tech scout** with Hunter Hines – Director, DeKalb Peachtree Airport (PDK), along with representatives from DEC and Chamblee are required.
3. Permits must be obtained by airport tenants (Airlines, Fixed Base Operators (FBO), Concessionaires, etc. for all film/photographic/video production work being conducted on property leased at the Airport under the control and jurisdiction of PDK.
4. Complete a film permit applications (DEC and Chamblee) via our Film Friendly Map on our website:
